



I began my career in Farm Broadcasting in 1986 working as an assistant to Colonel Dink Embry, who was Farm Director at WHOP in Hopkinsville. I continued working with Dink conducting interviews with local farmers, attending fairs and farm tours, and doing other assignments. I credit my time with Dink as learning the importance of making every person I interview feel important and that their story is special and unique. After graduating from Western Kentucky University in 1990 with a degree in Mass Communications and a minor in Animal Science, I worked full-time for WHOP as an announcer and continued my part-time work in farm broadcasting.

I left WHOP to work at WKDZ in Cadiz in 1993. After a number of years as News Director, in 2007 we decided to launch the Morning Ag Report after I won the Kentucky Farm Bureau Communications Award. After growing the show over the years, I was presented the opportunity in 2017 to take over hosting Kentucky Farm Bureau's Across Kentucky, that was developed by friend and fellow farm broadcaster, Mike Feldhaus. I continued working with Farm Bureau as host of Across Kentucky until March 15, 2020. Farm Bureau and I launched a new podcast called The Farmers Voice in April, 2020.

Edge Media Group launched the Your Ag Edge Network and signature program Travelin' the Bluegrass on March 16. Launching the program was a true dream of mine and I feel fortunate to have a team of dedicated partners at Edge Media Group to support the show. Since launching the network, our list of affiliate stations has continued to grow. I can't wait to see where we go in the future!
